

PACKING LIST

Gr. 9 Year-end Trip

May 16th – 18th, 2017

Here are some items students should bring on the trip. Keep in mind that space is VERY limited.... Students are allowed one medium to large sized duffle bag or bag (NO large suitcases please!) and a sleeping bag.

- Bag lunch (for Wednesday – Please: no nut or nut products / no storage containers / packed in a paper or plastic bag). Thank you!
- A WARM sleeping bag. Cabins are insulated, but can still get chilly! Place the sleeping bag in a large garbage bag, tied shut, with your child's name written on it.
- A flashlight – the cabins have electricity, but it is a good idea for outside at night.
- A swim suit.... Dress Code still applies.... **Absolutely NO 2-PIECE SUITS ALLOWED**... “Tankinis” must be modest and cover like a 1-piece suit.
- Facecloth & towel
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, washcloth, deodorants, hairbrush/comb, etc.).
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen and bug repellent.
- Clothing for the trippack for outdoor activities in both warm and cold weather (rain coat or poncho for rainy weather). We will be canoeing, doing team building activities, trail riding, etc. Be **SURE** to bring **appropriate clothing** for these activities and that are **within the school dress code!** Pack wisely!
- Two pairs of shoes: one for camping & activities, and one that can get wet (not flip flops though... they must be shoes that can be tied or secured, so they don't fall off in the water)
- A camera for the trip.
- **PLEASE BRING A RAIN COAT!**
- Any allergy medications or other medications needed on the trip... these must be listed on the Gr. 9 Year-End Class Trip Check List with directions and given to Mr. Langridge, Mr. Capton or Miss Stolte. Please place all medication in a ziploc bag with your child's name on the bag as well as the medication.
- Personal MP3 players, CD players, DS devices, etc. are allowed while traveling **ONLY**..... They will **NOT** be allowed at the camp, or in the cabins. The purpose of this trip is to build community among classmates! It goes without saying that we expect music, etc., to be acceptable and non-offensive.
- Pen/Pencil (for nightly devotions – paper provided)
- Tuck money (optional)
- ***A GREAT attitude and desire to have fun together!***

** Each student needs to:

- be able to carry their own luggage
- have their luggage and sleeping bag labeled or their name taped on the outside of the bag(s).
