- Executive Director Update

- Budget \$400 000 to build the playground. We currently have \$50 000. Planned events: garage sale(May 27th), Family Comedy Night, Food Basket Sale.

- Most of the money will likely come from Grants. Need approval from the City and the joint use committee. We will know by the end of June.
