

“Drop & Go” Zone:

A one minute parking zone to drop off & pick up children.

- **One direction** traffic flow for the “Drop & Go” zone on the north side of the school.
- **Vehicles must pull up** as far forward as possible when entering the “Drop & Go” zone.
- **Never double park.**
- **Drivers must remain in their vehicle** when children get out. Children need to travel with backpacks, school projects, etc. in the vehicle (not in the trunk).
- Children **must exit out the right side** of the vehicle to avoid unsafe parking lot or street traffic.
- After the student is safely out of the vehicle, you are to **proceed immediately.**
- **No U-turns.**

Park & Walk Zone:

- Designated parking for parents/visitors.
- Please park in the parent parking areas if your child is not capable of getting out of the vehicle on their own.

Recommended Drop-off & Pick-up Zones:

Kinder & Gr. 1 students:

If your youngest child is in kindergarten please use: the “Park & Walk” zone on the west end of 59th street; the “Drop & Go” zone or “Park & Walk” zone on the north side of the school.

Grade 2 – 5 students:

If your youngest child is in Gr. 2 – 5 please use the “Drop & Go” or “Park & Walk” zones on the north side of the school.

Grade 6 – 12 students:

If your youngest child is in Gr. 6 – 12 please use the “Drop & Go” zone on the east end of 59th street or the “Park & Walk” zone on the north side of the school.

Before & After School Supervision

Please do **NOT** drop off your child prior to 8:20 a.m. and pick up your child no later than 3:30 p.m. as there is **no adult supervision outside of these times.** (Please make alternate child care arrangements if necessary). Thank you!



What does it mean?

During the designated posted times (8:00 – 17:00) do not stop or park in the “No Parking” zones for any reason.



What does it mean?

On school days, the speed limit within a school zone is 30 km/hr. from: 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. / 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. / 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.



What does it mean?

The speed within Playground Zones is 30 km/hr. and is in effect from: 8:30 a.m. to one hour after sunset each day of the week.



What does it mean?

You cannot stop or park in the bus zone (Monday – Friday) unless you are driving a bus.

To lessen congestion around the school and make it safer for everyone’s children, please consider sharing the driving with other parents who live in your area of town.
